

# COVID-19 RESPONSE AND ECONOMIC RECOVERY OMNIBUS ACT 2020

### **ORDER**

#### **MADE UNDER SECTION 8(1)**

## WAIVER, REFUND OR REDUCTION OF FEES FOR SPECIFIED AGENTS LICENCES

- I, Christopher John Dawson, Commissioner of Police of Western Australia and chief 1. executive officer of the agency principally assisting in the administration of the Security and Related Activities (Control) Act 1996, pursuant to section 8(1) of the Covid-19 Response and Economic Recovery Omnibus Act 2020, order that -
- 2. The following agent's licences issued under section 49(1)(c) of the Security and Related Activities (Control) Act 1996 are 'relevant licences' for the purpose of this order
  - a. Security agent's licence referred to in section 15;
  - b. Crowd control agent's licence referred to in section 36;
  - c. Inquiry agent's licence referred to in section 29.
- All licence holders in possession of a current relevant licence on 1 July 2020 shall be 3. issued a refund of one third of the prescribed fee for renewal, calculated on the basis of the prescribed fee in the year the relevant licence was issued, as follows -

Year issued	Prescribed fee (\$)	Refund (\$)
1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020	843	281
1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019	766	256
1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018	709	237

In the alternative, a relevant licence holder who applies for renewal of a relevant licence 4. in the period between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2021, shall, subject to the Commissioner's discretion, be issued with the renewal of that licence on payment of the reduced fee of \$574.66.

This order is made under Subdivision 2 of Part 2 of the Covid-19 Response and Economic Recovery 10

Omnibus Act 2020 and ceases to have effect when that Subdivision ceases to have effect.
